



George-Cornel Dumitrescu, PhD, senior research fellow and coordinator of the Department of Structural Changes at the World Economy of IWE, has a strong background in the area of macroeconomics. He has worked on and coordinated a multitude of research studies in this field. In 2015, he completed his postdoctoral studies through a project financed by the European Social Fund.

Mr. Dumitrescu has attended a significant number of scientific conferences at national and international level, as well as published numerous scientific papers in various fields.
