### Main activities and responsibilities:

Simona MOAGĂR-POLADIAN, PhD, senior research fellow and Managing Director of IWE has background in the areas of structural changes in the world economy, international economic relations and economic integration. She has worked on over 100 research studies as author and coordinator as well as co-director of Global Economic Observer Journal, in cooperation with Titulescu University, and of Journal of Global Economics. She is the author and co-author of several books, chapters and articles focused on EU integration, exchange rates and stock markets, structural changes of world economy, some being published in international journals and international publishing houses. Since 2014, Moagăr-Poladian has coordinated the Academic Annual Research Programme entitled „New criteria for European Integration and Globalization. Nominal and Real Convergence“ (<http://iem.ro/proiecte/programe-ale-academiei-romane/>) and she is responsible for coordinating and supervising the scientific activity of approximately 40 researchers. Simona assumed in 2018 the position of National Commission Member for the substantiation of the euro adoption National Plan.

Between 1994 and 1998, she produced an economic program, i.e. "From the Business World", aired daily, from Monday to Friday for a national broadcasting station. This production presented the evolution of the exchange rates of the main currencies at London and New York Stock Exchange, as well as the main events of the world economy and international trade, which in that period had consequences of visibility as good practice on the profile activity. She has been main coordinator for a grant financed by U.S. Department of State for studying the financial markets in U.S. Within this grant, during a research visit in U.S., she has analysed the functioning of NYSE, AMEX, and Chicago Mercantile Exchange stock markets, conducted interviews with Merton Miller, a Nobel Prize winner, and also with FED Philadelphia governor, and with some local investors (networking).

Between 2014 and 2015, she managed a National Project for Doctoral and Postdoctoral studies under European Social Fund and coordinated 105 PhD students and 150 postdoctoral students in Fundamental and Applied Scientific Research.

Since April 2020 she is also the manager of the Centre for Writing European Projects in the field of Climate Change submitted to the Institute for World Economy and funded by the Competitiveness Operational Program.
